RCAC Advisory Meeting June 9, 2022

Minutes from the last meeting were approved
Bob O' Malley has stepped down; Ron Kurtz representing pickle is in his place.

Updates:

1. Rhett will create a charging doc for hose connection, for paddle, while Debbie is checking w/PW to see if a line can be run from the ball field.
2. Rhett will be arranging a meeting with designated survey members asap for June.

Center-wide Issues

1. Hard court maintenance & repairs on pickle and tennis will take place after pickle courts are done.
2. Rhett is creating a charging doc for light repair Court 10, to escalate the work order that is over 90 days old. **(this was fixed on 6-14).**
3. The RCAC agreed to create a Data Sub-Committee that collects and disaggregates data on membership and court usage for all 3 sports, we are requesting that monthly membership lists for each sport be sent to Karen Kaplan, who will head the Sub-Committee. The sub-committee will report data trends periodically to the RCAC to determine needs and opportunities for promotion and center programs.
4. We are requesting that a system be put into place with the Northstar platform to allow for the attendant to indicate which sport a player is participating in. This will allow for each sport to access the activity of the sport. This should include members (who have multiple sports memberships) and guest. We request that this data be shared with the RCAC and the designated person for each sport.
