

OPA Elections Committee Ballot/Vote Count 9/30/22

The hand counting of paper ballots today verified the number of paper ballots received, including duplicates requested by owners of multiple properties and requests for other reasons. This hand count also verified that the tabulation program needs to be investigated to identify the reason for the reporting an excess of votes, above the maximum number of paper ballots, that were scanned on 8/11/22. The failure to verify the information generated by the tabulation program resulted in an inaccurate report of results by Elections Committee Chair.
