New Business:

1. Colby gave a brief overview of how the summer went for Recs and Parks. It was a busy summer and everything went well.
2. Colby gave an update on the 2 tennis courts at the Swim and Racquet Club. The courts have fallen into disrepair and need to be renovated . OP is looking to resurface the courts and repair the fencing around the facility. It was discussed if this work could be tied together with removal of the asphalt area where the other 2 old courts were and additional.
3. Colby gave a brief update on her plans for her upcoming budget. Since there wasn't any money available for capital budget requests last year and all were denied she is going to put everything back in for next year (pump track, lighted trail, exercise equipment).
4. The group discussed goals for Committee for the upcoming year and planning ideas for the future. Various discussions and ideas occurred over the course of the conversation.
5. Existing Playground/ Park survey. The Recs and Parks committee will work on creating a master list of playgrounds and parks with their current equipment and conditions. This survey will take into account the accessibility of all of the equipment on the sites. Survey list to follow in separate email.
6. Crab Pier in the sanctuary update and discussion. The options that OPA is looking at were discussed. The Recs and Parks committee would like to see the pier repaired in its current location. The neighbors have some issues that need to be addressed to but it should be kept in its current location as an amenity for Ocean Pines.
