

2025 Board of Directors Election Frequently Asked Questions

When will ballots be mailed?

Ballots will be mailed via U.S. mail on July 8, 2025. Paper ballots will only be mailed to the address on file with the OPA Administration.

Will I be able to vote electronically this year?

Yes, emails will be sent to all eligible voters on July 9, 2025. The email will include everything you need to cast your ballot online. Electronic voting packages will only be sent to the email address on file with OPA Administration.

Can I drop my ballot off without mailing it?

Yes, a drop box will be available in the lobby of the Police Department. All votes must be packaged as specified in the ballot materials to ensure secrecy of your ballot. The drop box will close at noon on Wednesday, August 6, 2025.

I didn't get a ballot in the mail or in email, what should I do?

Please leave the name of the homeowner of record, OPA address and a number or email where we can reach you. Note paper ballots will be mailed to the address on file with the OPA Administration. Electronic voting packages will only be sent to the email address on file with OPA Administration.

I got a letter saying I'm not eligible to vote, what can I do to become eligible?

All owners of lots within Ocean Pines are eligible to vote, providing the lot Assessment has been paid and there are no current CPI violations for the property. Contact the OPA Administration for information about what needs to be resolved.

Where can I find information about the Candidates?

Ballot packages mailed to each eligible address will include candidate biography statements, photo, and answers to three questions. Additional information can be obtained by attending the Candidate Forum to be held on Friday, June 27, 2025 at 5:00 PM at the Golf Clubhouse.
