**FROM:** Chief James L. Ehrisman **SUBJ:** Police Vehicle Replacement

At this time I would like to provide a little background on the use of our police vehicles. We are currently the only police department in Worcester County that does NOT have a take-home vehicle program for its officers. While this hurts us in recruitment and retention, it does enable us to keep the police fleet small. To illustrate this, the two similar sized police agencies in our County: Berlin (15 vehicles) and Pocomoke (17 vehicles) have much larger fleets.

In our agency, we may have 6 marked vehicles on the road on weekends between 9PM and 3AM, when our two patrol shifts overlap on the busiest days of the week. Some of our police vehicles run 24 hours per day, unlike departments with take-home vehicles. In those departments, the vehicle is only operated 8-10 hours, and only when the officer is working. This enables these departments to keep the vehicles much longer.

Our police vehicles show dramatic increase in repairs when they reach the 125,000 mile mark. Remember, these vehicles are often operated 24 hours per day, and the engines have many more hours on them, when they are run at idle. There are some years we request no vehicle replacement, and some years we request one or two, due to mileage. The replacement vehicles we have requested are the two oldest vehicles in our fleet.

#### **Vehicles of the Ocean Pines Police Department needed to replace:**

2011 Ford Expedition Mileage 176567 (Major engine issues)

2014 Ford Explorer Mileage 143730 (Major repairs, Seats door panels interior ect.) Replacing these Fords with the Chevy Tahoe has been found to be the best package and price for the current STATE CONTRACTED PRICE used by neighboring police agencies. It fits the physical needs as the size of the vehicle for practical use for officers, equipment and transport needs.
