### New Business

1. Introduction of new committee members. Matt is a project manager at Salisbury University and has extensive expertise with sports facilities.

2. Construction of the White Horse Park Restrooms and Storage Room. Construction through the summer will be problematic for the summer camps. The camps are sold out.

3. Playground equipment for White Horse Park. Nothing will happen there over the summer because of heavy use. Fall Project.

4. Relocation of the playground at Mandolin Meadows. This project is standing still. Public works has had the equipment but have not installed it.

5. Construction and installation of 8 pickle ball courts at Mandolin Creek Racquet Center. Two tennis courts #11 & 12 will become pickle ball courts.

If the courts cannot be built promptly then tennis should use them one more season. If they can be constructed lights will need to be added in order to keep the schedule with evening play. Platform Tennis is planning to build more courts as well but interest has diminished. Also they are not allowing any youth membership.

6. Membership numbers for the free trial week at the Racquet Center. Junior Tennis Tourney will be held on July 23.

7. Construction of the multi-purpose field at Huntington Park. \$27,145 for the playground equipment. The area will be graded. Completion Sept.1

8. Installation of the new gym floor in the community center. 3 Bids, 2 with the same product, some testing must be done, the price is higher than expected.

9. Exercise facility at the Pines. Our committee feels that the Walgreens would make a great location for a gym. Its the most requested imenity, this building is close to the ports core pool, tennis etc.
